Student Chair Role Description & Skills

The Student Chair of the MIND Youth Program works closely with the Executive Director and the Programming Committee to assist with planning MIND Mentor meetings and MIND Youth Program events. This is a leadership position requiring the following skills:

- Strong communication and organizational skills.
- Ability to explain and speak about your learning difference (well-developed story)
- Strong self-advocacy skills & willingness to share experiences

Student Chair Role Responsibilities

- Attend MIND Youth Program events (Typically 4 per year)
- Attend MIND Mentor Meetings (3-5 per year)
- Attend additional PC READS events as identified, possibly including speaking engagements
- Volunteer at PC READS events
- Volunteer at PC READS fundraisers (Live PC Give PC & Spring Fundraiser)
- Provide photo and bio for MIND website and assist with gathering other MIND Mentor photos and bios
- Respond to emails and texts promptly
- Assist with shopping for event and meeting supplies
- Assist with sharing event information
- Assist with organizing MIND Mentor meetings
 - Use of group texts to share meeting dates and ask for RSVPs
 - Review of agenda prior to meeting
- Lead MIND Mentor meetings
- Lead MIND Youth Program events
