

## DYSLEXIA SCREENING PACKAGE

PC READS offers a comprehensive Dyslexia Screening Package, utilizing the Neurolearning Dyslexia Screening Test App, which was developed by Drs. Brock and Fernette Eide. They have been on the forefront of dyslexia research for years, are the authors of "The Dyslexic Advantage: Unlocking the Hidden Potential of the Dyslexic Brain," and the developers of <a href="https://www.dyslexicadvantage.org/">www.dyslexicadvantage.org/</a>.

This screening is available to students aged 7 and older and takes about an hour to complete. Your Advocate can share more information about the screening and arrange to have a screening appointment scheduled.

Included in the result is a **DYSLEXIA SCREENING SCORE**, which provides an overall assessment of the person's risk for dyslexia, and how likely they are to show dyslexia-associated difficulties with reading, spelling, and other academic skills. **This is not a diagnostic test, but it does share with families if their child displays dyslexic traits.** The reports also provide specific actions to take to improve skills affected by dyslexia including phonemic awareness, reading, spelling, and writing. Our Dyslexia Screening Package includes the following:

- Initial consultation with an Advocate Team Member (30-60 minutes)
- Screening Appointment: Typically, students attend on their own; however, parents may stay and observe (60-90 minutes)
- Results Appointment: Advocate Team Member meets with parent(s) and assists with interpreting report data and provides guidance on how to use the screening results to obtain additional support (60-90 minutes)
- "Next Steps" Email: Advocate Team Member provides a summary of suggested next steps and additional resources; Parents also have the opportunity to continue working with an Advocate Team Member
